

## FBC 101 Class 3 – Divine Revelation in Human Context (A Biblical example)

**1Timothy 2:12** I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man; rather, she is to remain quiet.

**1Timothy 2:13** For Adam was formed first, then Eve;

**1Timothy 2:14** and Adam was not deceived, but the woman was deceived and became a transgressor.

**1Timothy 2:15** Yet she will be saved through childbearing—if they continue in faith and love and holiness, with self-control.

**1Timothy 3:1** The saying is trustworthy: If anyone aspires to the office of overseer, he desires a noble task.

**1Timothy 3:2** Therefore an overseer must be above reproach, the husband of one wife, sober-minded, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach,

**1Timothy 3:8** Deacons likewise must be dignified, not double-tongued, not addicted to much wine, not greedy for dishonest gain.

**1Timothy 5:17** Let the elders who rule well be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in preaching and teaching.

**1Corinthians 11:3** But I want you to understand that the head of every man is Christ, the head of a wife is her husband, and the head of Christ is God.

**1Corinthians 11:4** Every man who prays or prophesies with his head covered dishonors his head,

**1Corinthians 11:5** but every wife who prays or prophesies with her head uncovered dishonors her head, since it is the same as if her head were shaven.

**1Corinthians 11:6** For if a wife will not cover her head, then she should cut her hair short. But since it is disgraceful for a wife to cut off her hair or shave her head, let her cover her head.

**1Corinthians 11:7** For a man ought not to cover his head, since he is the image and glory of God, but woman is the glory of man.

**1Corinthians 11:8** For man was not made from woman, but woman from man.

**1Corinthians 11:9** Neither was man created for woman, but woman for man.

**1Corinthians 11:10** That is why a wife ought to have a symbol of authority on her head, because of the angels.

**1Corinthians 11:11** Nevertheless, in the Lord woman is not independent of man nor man of woman;

**1Corinthians 11:12** for as woman was made from man, so man is now born of woman. And all things are from God.

**1Corinthians 11:13** Judge for yourselves: is it proper for a wife to pray to God with her head uncovered?

**1Corinthians 11:14** Does not nature itself teach you that if a man wears long hair it is a disgrace for him,

**1Corinthians 11:15** but if a woman has long hair, it is her glory? For her hair is given to her for a covering.

**1Corinthians 11:16** If anyone is inclined to be contentious, we have no such practice, nor do the churches of God.

**1Corinthians 14:34** the women should keep silent in the churches. For they are not permitted to speak, but should be in submission, as the Law also says.

**1Corinthians 14:35** If there is anything they desire to learn, let them ask their husbands at home. For it is shameful for a woman to speak in church.

**Romans 16:1** I commend to you our sister Phoebe, a servant of the church at Cenchreae,

**Galatians 3:28** There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

**Ephesians 2:20** built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone,

**Luke 2:36** And there was a prophetess, Anna, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was advanced in years, having lived with her husband seven years from when she was a virgin,

**Acts 21:9** He had four unmarried daughters, who prophesied.

**1Corinthians 11:11** Nevertheless, in the Lord woman is not independent of man nor man of woman;

**Ephesians 5:21** submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.

**1Corinthians 7:3** The husband should give to his wife her conjugal rights, and likewise the wife to her husband.

**1Corinthians 7:4** For the wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. Likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does.

**Exodus 20:17** “You shall not covet your neighbor’s house; you shall not covet your neighbor’s wife, or his male servant, or his female servant, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything that is your neighbor’s.”
