

## Sovereignty of God - Pt.3 - God's Sovereignty in Election

**Romans 11:7 ¶** What then? Israel failed to obtain what it was seeking. The elect obtained it, but the rest were hardened,

**Galatians 6:15** For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation.

**Galatians 6:16** And as for all who walk by this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God.

**Romans 11:23** And even they, if they do not continue in their unbelief, will be grafted in, for God has the power to graft them in again.

**Romans 11:24** For if you were cut from what is by nature a wild olive tree, and grafted, contrary to nature, into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these, the natural branches, be grafted back into their own olive tree.

**Romans 11:25 ¶** Lest you be wise in your own sight, I do not want you to be unaware of this mystery, brothers: a partial hardening has come upon Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.

**Romans 11:26** And in this way all Israel will be saved, as it is written, “The Deliverer will come from Zion, he will banish ungodliness from Jacob”;

**Romans 11:27** “and this will be my covenant with them when I take away their sins.”

**Romans 11:28 ¶** As regards the gospel, they are enemies for your sake. But as regards election, they are beloved for the sake of their forefathers.

**Romans 11:29** For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

**Romans 11:30** For just as you were at one time disobedient to God but now have received mercy because of their disobedience,

**Romans 11:31** so they too have now been disobedient in order that by the mercy shown to you they also may now receive mercy.

**Romans 11:32** For God has consigned all to disobedience, that he may have mercy on all.

**Matthew 24:22** And if those days had not been cut short, no human being would be saved. But for the sake of the elect those days will be cut short.

**Matthew 24:23** Then if anyone says to you, ‘Look, here is the Christ!’ or ‘There he is!’ do not believe it.

**Matthew 24:24** For false christians and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect.

**Matthew 24:25** See, I have told you beforehand.

**Matthew 24:26** So, if they say to you, ‘Look, he is in the wilderness,’ do not go out. If they say, ‘Look, he is in the inner rooms,’ do not believe it.

**Matthew 24:27** For as the lightning comes from the east and shines as far as the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.

**Matthew 24:28** Wherever the corpse is, there the vultures will gather.

**Matthew 24:29 ¶** “Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

**Matthew 24:30** Then will appear in heaven the sign of the Son of Man, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

**Matthew 24:31** And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

**2Timothy 2:10** Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

**Romans 3:10** as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one;

**Romans 3:23** for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

**Romans 5:12 ¶** Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned—

**Romans 5:13** for sin indeed was in the world before the law was given, but sin is not counted where there is no law.

**Romans 5:14** Yet death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those whose sinning was not like the transgression of Adam, who was a type of the one who was to come.

**Romans 5:15 ¶** But the free gift is not like the trespass. For if many died through one man's trespass, much more have the grace of God and the free gift by the grace of that one man Jesus Christ abounded for many.

**Romans 5:16** And the free gift is not like the result of that one man's sin. For the judgment following one trespass brought condemnation, but the free gift following many trespasses brought justification.

**Romans 5:17** For if, because of one man's trespass, death reigned through that one man, much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and the free gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man Jesus Christ.

**Romans 5:18 ¶** Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men.

**Romans 5:19** For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous.

**Isaiah 53:6** All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

**1John 1:8** If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

**1John 1:9** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**1John 1:10** If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

**Colossians 2:13** And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses,

**Ephesians 2:1 ¶** And you were dead in the trespasses and sins

**Joshua 24:15** And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the LORD, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."

**Joshua 24:22** Then Joshua said to the people, “You are witnesses against yourselves that you have chosen the LORD, to serve him.” And they said, “We are witnesses.”

**Romans 9:11** though they were not yet born and had done nothing either good or bad—in order that God’s purpose of election might continue, not because of works but because of him who calls—

**Romans 11:5** So too at the present time there is a remnant, chosen by grace.

**Romans 11:6** But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works; otherwise grace would no longer be grace.

**Romans 11:7 ¶** What then? Israel failed to obtain what it was seeking. The elect obtained it, but the rest were hardened,

**Ephesians 2:8** For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,

**Ephesians 2:9** not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

**Ephesians 2:10** For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

**John 15:16** You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you.

**1Timothy 2:3** This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior,

**1Timothy 2:4** who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

**1Timothy 2:5** For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

**1Timothy 2:6** who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time.

**Acts 13:48 ¶** And when the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord, and as many as were appointed to eternal life believed.

**Ephesians 1:4** even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love

**Revelation 13:8** and all who dwell on earth will worship it, everyone whose name has not been written before the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who was slain.

**Romans 9:6 ¶** But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For not all who are descended from Israel belong to Israel,

**Romans 11:23** And even they, if they do not continue in their unbelief, will be grafted in, for God has the power to graft them in again.

**2Peter 3:9** The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.

**Acts 13:48 ¶** And when the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord, and as many as were appointed to eternal life believed.

**Romans 9:19 ¶** You will say to me then, “Why does he still find fault? For who can resist his will?”

**Acts 4:27 ¶** for truly in this city there were gathered together against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles and the peoples of Israel,

**Acts 4:28** to do whatever your hand and your plan had predestined to take place.

**Ephesians 1:13** In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit,

**Ephesians 1:14** who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.

**Philippians 1:6** And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

**John 6:37** All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out.

**John 6:38** For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me.

**John 6:39** And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day.

**John 6:40** For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.”

**John 6:41 ¶** So the Jews grumbled about him, because he said, “I am the bread that came down from heaven.”

**John 6:42** They said, “Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How does he now say, ‘I have come down from heaven?’”

**John 6:43** Jesus answered them, “Do not grumble among yourselves.

**John 6:44** No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day.

**John 6:45** It is written in the Prophets, ‘And they will all be taught by God.’ Everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to me—

**John 6:46** not that anyone has seen the Father except he who is from God; he has seen the Father.

**John 6:47** Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes has eternal life.

**John 10:27** My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.

**John 10:28** I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand.

**John 10:29** My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father’s hand.

**John 10:30** I and the Father are one.”

**Romans 8:28** And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.

**Romans 8:29** For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.

**Romans 8:30** And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified.

**Matthew 24:24** For false christ's and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect.

**2Peter 1:10** Therefore, brothers, be all the more diligent to confirm your calling and election, for if you practice these qualities you will never fall.

**Hebrews 6:4** For it is impossible, in the case of those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, and have shared in the Holy Spirit,

**Hebrews 6:5** and have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the age to come,

**Hebrews 6:6** and then have fallen away, to restore them again to repentance, since they are crucifying once again the Son of God to their own harm and holding him up to contempt.

**Jeremiah 17:9 ¶** The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it?

**Jeremiah 31:33** For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

**Jeremiah 31:34** And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."

**Ezekiel 36:25** I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you.

**Ezekiel 36:26** And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.

**Ezekiel 36:27** And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules.

**Ephesians 1:10** as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

**Ephesians 1:11 ¶** In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will,

**Ephesians 1:12** so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory.
