

**Daniel 7:13** “I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before him.

**Daniel 7:14** And to him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.

**2Samuel 7:15** but my steadfast love will not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you.

**2Samuel 7:16** And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.”

**2Samuel 7:17** In accordance with all these words, and in accordance with all this vision, Nathan spoke to David.

**Numbers 23:19** God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?

**Psalms 144:3** O LORD, what is man that you regard him, or the son of man that you think of him?

**Joel 2:28** “And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions.

**Isaiah 53:1** Who has believed what he has heard from us? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

**Isaiah 53:2** For he grew up before him like a young plant, and like a root out of dry ground; he had no form or majesty that we should look at him, and no beauty that we should desire him.

**Isaiah 53:3** He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

**Isaiah 53:4** Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

**Isaiah 53:5** But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.

**Isaiah 53:6** All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

**Isaiah 53:7** He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth; like a lamb that is led to the slaughter, and like a sheep that before its shearers is silent, so he opened not his mouth.

**Isaiah 53:8** By oppression and judgment he was taken away; and as for his generation, who considered that he was cut off out of the land of the living, stricken for the transgression of my people?

**Isaiah 53:9** And they made his grave with the wicked and with a rich man in his death, although he had done no violence, and there was no deceit in his mouth.

**Isaiah 53:10** Yet it was the will of the LORD to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

**Isaiah 53:11** Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities.

**Isaiah 53:12** Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.

**Isaiah 54:4** “Fear not, for you will not be ashamed; be not confounded, for you will not be disgraced; for you will forget the shame of your youth, and the reproach of your widowhood you will remember no more.

**Isaiah 54:5** For your Maker is your husband, the LORD of hosts is his name; and the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer, the God of the whole earth he is called.

**Isaiah 54:6** For the LORD has called you like a wife deserted and grieved in spirit, like a wife of youth when she is cast off, says your God.

**Isaiah 54:7** For a brief moment I deserted you, but with great compassion I will gather you.

**Isaiah 41:8** But you, Israel, my servant, Jacob, whom I have chosen, the offspring of Abraham, my friend;

**Isaiah 52:13** Behold, my servant shall act wisely; he shall be high and lifted up, and shall be exalted.

**Matthew 8:17** This was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah: “He took our illnesses and bore our diseases.”

**Acts 8:32** Now the passage of the Scripture that he was reading was this: “Like a sheep he was led to the slaughter and like a lamb before its shearer is silent, so he opens not his mouth.

**Acts 8:33** In his humiliation justice was denied him. Who can describe his generation? For his life is taken away from the earth.”

**1Peter 2:24** He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.

**2Corinthians 5:21** For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

**1Corinthians 1:30** And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption,

**John 15:4** Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me.

**John 15:5** I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.

**John 12:24** Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.

**Colossians 1:27** To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

**John 1:12** But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God,

**John 1:13** who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.
